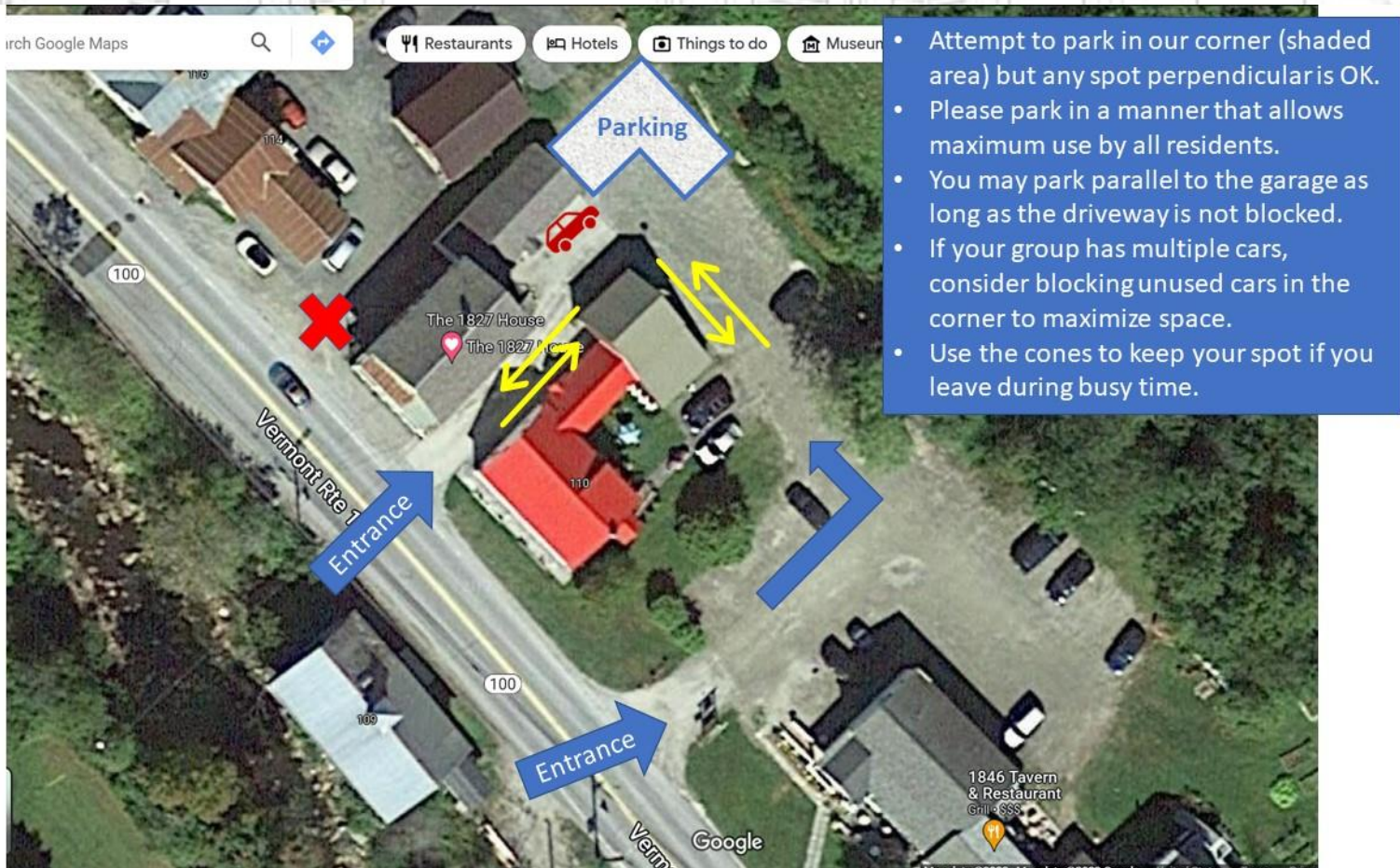
We are directly on RT100 about 6 miles north of Wilmington. We share a parking lot with the West Dover Inn and the 1846 Tavern.

The closest major airports are Albany NY (ALB) and Bradley in Hartford CT (BDL)

## Parking

Parking is behind the house. If you are staying upstairs you can park temporarily to unload at the front of the house.

Please note that overflow from the West Dover Inn and 1846 Tavern sometimes encroaches on the parking and the alleyway is shared access.



# CHECKING IN

Check-in time is anytime after 3:00 PM. We sometimes adjust later if significant turnover is needed. We are happy to arrange early check-in times whenever possible.

## Additional check-in information

We have keyless entry for each unit and the whole house. Downstairs/Whole House is via the rear door with the overhang next to the garage. Upstairs is via the front LEFT door facing the house from the front porch.

A personal PIN will be sent via messaging. It is usually the last 4 digits of your registered phone number.

1. Touch the Yale symbol on keypad
2. Enter PIN
3. Press Check Mark. The Lock should allow entry.

When leaving press the Yale symbol at the top of the keypad to lock. The lock can be locked and unlocked manually from inside.

There is a door that separates the units in the vestibule. If you are renting the entire house your code will work for both doors and we will have the connecting door open. If you need the combo for the vestibule door please ask. There is a slide lock from the upstairs side when rented separately.

**The downstairs hallway door by the laundry unlocks when opened. Please ensure the door is locked after opening. The door is for emergency exit only and not routine access.**

There is a night latch lock for the front door from downstairs which can be unlocked to exit/enter from the front of the house.

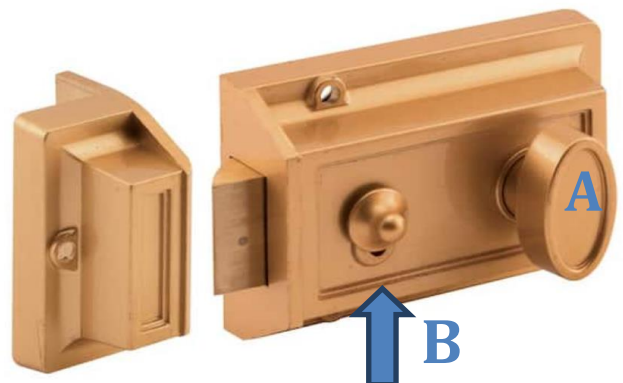

*Turn knob (A) to exit.*

*Turn knob (A) and raise lock (B) to allow passage without locking yourself out. Release (B) to allow the door to lock.*

*Raising (B) while locked will prevent the key from unlocking the door from the outside for extra security.*

# ACCESSING WIFI



Network name: 112RT100 Guest

Password: 1827house

Internet is high-speed fiber and is transmitted throughout the house via a EERO mesh system.

One node is in the back hallway on the window sill to support the downstairs bedrooms and entryway. It is very important to not relocate this node as it supports the keypad lock for entry.

The second node is on the second floor on the book shelf.

The main node is in the hutch on the first floor as well as the incoming control unit.

Please let us know if there are any issues.

# Heat Controls

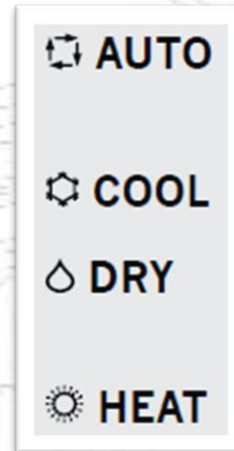


There are several options for heat.

Please use the Mitsubishi split duct units which each have a remote. They can be used for heating and cooling. The Honeywell Home thermostat on the wall is for backup heat only and not cooling.

1. Great room: (*Downstairs Zone*)
2. King Room: (*Downstairs Zone*)
3. Queen Room: (*Upstairs Zone*)
4. Living room: (*Upstairs Zone*)
5. Loft: (*Upstairs Zone*)

The following video will describe the remote options. The symbols can be confusing and hard to see. Please use either Cool (2<sup>nd</sup> Mode) or Heat (4<sup>th</sup> Mode) and all units in the zone **must** be on the same mode. The last selected will be the only one that works and the other(s) will lockout until matched.

There are several MYSA controls on the walls which are used for electric baseboard heat in that zone area. Just tap the arrows on the MYSA to control. These are monitored remotely and are only for Heat AND NOT AC.

The shower on the first floor has a heated floor. The schedule can be activated or operated manually. The heated floor not only feels nice but helps with steam control as there is no vent. There is also a small dehumidifier to assist with steam. There is also a heated towel rack to enjoy. Please read the warning prior to using.

The baseboard heat in the upstairs and loft bathrooms are manually controlled on the heater. Please remember to turn them off if used. (Not powered in the summer)

When temperatures are very cold we may switch over to the Propane Furnace controlled remotely and at the Honeywell controller in the main room.

The propane fireplace upstairs is controlled via remote next to the TV or on the sill of the fireplace. Please ensure it is attended to when in use.

The electric fireplace downstairs can be used for heat but please do not use it excessively for heat but rather for providing some ambiance lighting and localized comfort. Very nice for warming the feet after the slopes :). If it beeps just unplug to reset it.

Please contact us if you have any issues with the heat or AC.

## Laundry

There is a washer and dryer combination in both units.

The upstairs units are smaller and have a ventless dryer installed with a drain so the tank does not need to be emptied. It takes a little longer to dry and may feel a little damp when complete but that is normal. You should notice that they are dry once removed but feel damp in the dryer.

The downstairs washer and dryer are larger and direct vent. We have the washer set for auto dispensing so you do not need to add detergent or softener. Just select your desired cycle and press start. If you wish to use your own detergent please ask and we will turn off the auto dispensing remotely.

**\*Please do not add detergent when in auto dispensing mode.**

Please clean the lint screen after each use.

There is detergent available for use. We provide fragrance free in case of any allergies.

Please do not bleach clothes.

You do not need to start a load of laundry when checking out.

## Entertainment

The hutch in the main room contains the Frame TV. The remote for the TV and soundbar should be on the coffee table. Feel free to kick back and relax (feet are allowed on the coffee table). There is a BluRay player in the hutch also and assorted movies for your use.

Browse the artwork on the Frame. The Frame may maintain a picture even when the TV is off and motion is sensed in the room.

There are DVDs in the hutch downstairs and a DVD/book library by the spiral stairs on the second floor. The Vermont classic "Funny Farm" shot in nearby Townsend VT is playable on Amazon under My Stuff.

There are games in the hutch, cards and UNO in the side table beside the hutch, and some games in the loft inside the locker at the seating area.

There is also a guitar in the loft.

# Latte Go

(Downstairs unit) We wanted to serve great coffee without the hassle and mess. The Latte-Go more than fits that bill and we hope you enjoy it. We provide coffee roasted locally or from our good friends in CT. You are welcome to use your own beans.

When the machine warms up and shuts down a small amount of water will be flushed.

Load the beans in the hopper, select and enjoy. Unused cream can be stored in the fridge. There is a bypass chute at the front of the hopper (the smaller lid). It is for pre-ground coffee. Please ensure no beans are placed in the bypass. It is taped to help prevent mistaking the chute for the hopper.

(Upstairs) There is an espresso machine in the cabinet above the fridge in addition to the drip coffee machine on the counter.

If you prefer drip coffee there is one located in the upstairs kitchen with a grinder. A drip machine/Keurig combo is also downstairs.

The house water is filtered and softened and there is a filter in the LatteGo and the coffee machine. More info can be found at:

- First Aid Kits are in both bathrooms under the sinks.
- Pack and Play and Child Gate are in the King Room closet
- Iron with board in the King Room closet and upstairs kitchen tall cabinet
- Roll away bed is in the King Room closet
- An air mattress is stored in the chest in the King Room
- Additional serving glasses are in the hutch upstairs
- Various manuals are in the coffee table drawer downstairs and hutch drawer upstairs
- There is an Echo 8 (Alexa) in the hutch that can be used. Please keep the camera covered.
- Ice Melt is in the garage



- When separate guests are occupying both units, please be quiet after 10 PM. There is also a town quiet ordinance after 10 PM.
- No parties or events allowed without owner's permission.
- No unregistered overnight guests. Let us know if you want to add any guests during your stay. Visitors during the day are welcome.
- No open flames or candles
- No smoking allowed. Smoking is allowed outside in the driveway but not on any part of the building such as the front porch and back deck. Please cleanup after yourself also. Thank you.
- Please separate recycles. Each kitchen has two bins, use one for recycling and one for trash. Dover uses a single stream system so all recyclables are placed together. Recycle and regular trash may be placed in the garage area when bins are full. Please do not use the dumpster at the Inn/Tavern. If you don't need to change out the garbage then you can leave it in the house bins and we will take care of it. Don't leave any garbage outside as it will attract bears and other animals.
- Please cleanup after pets inside and outside. Pets must be on leash and attended to when outside. There is a pet poop station (bags and disposal) at the town hall just down the street.
- Please respect the neighbors. They are very friendly and helpful.
- Please don't rearrange large furniture (Table, sofas, and beds).
- No illegal substances allowed on the premises.
- Second-floor balcony (front) is for Emergency egress only.
- The basement has very low ceilings. Please do not enter unless an emergency.
- The garage can only be used for storage and garbage/recycle. Please respect the owners maintenance items.
- Fireplaces must be attended.
- Sneakers/slippers/inside shoes are recommended. No outside (muddy) boots or ski boots past the mudroom please

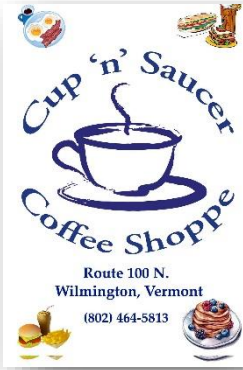

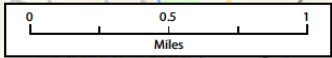

connecting Dover and Wilmington

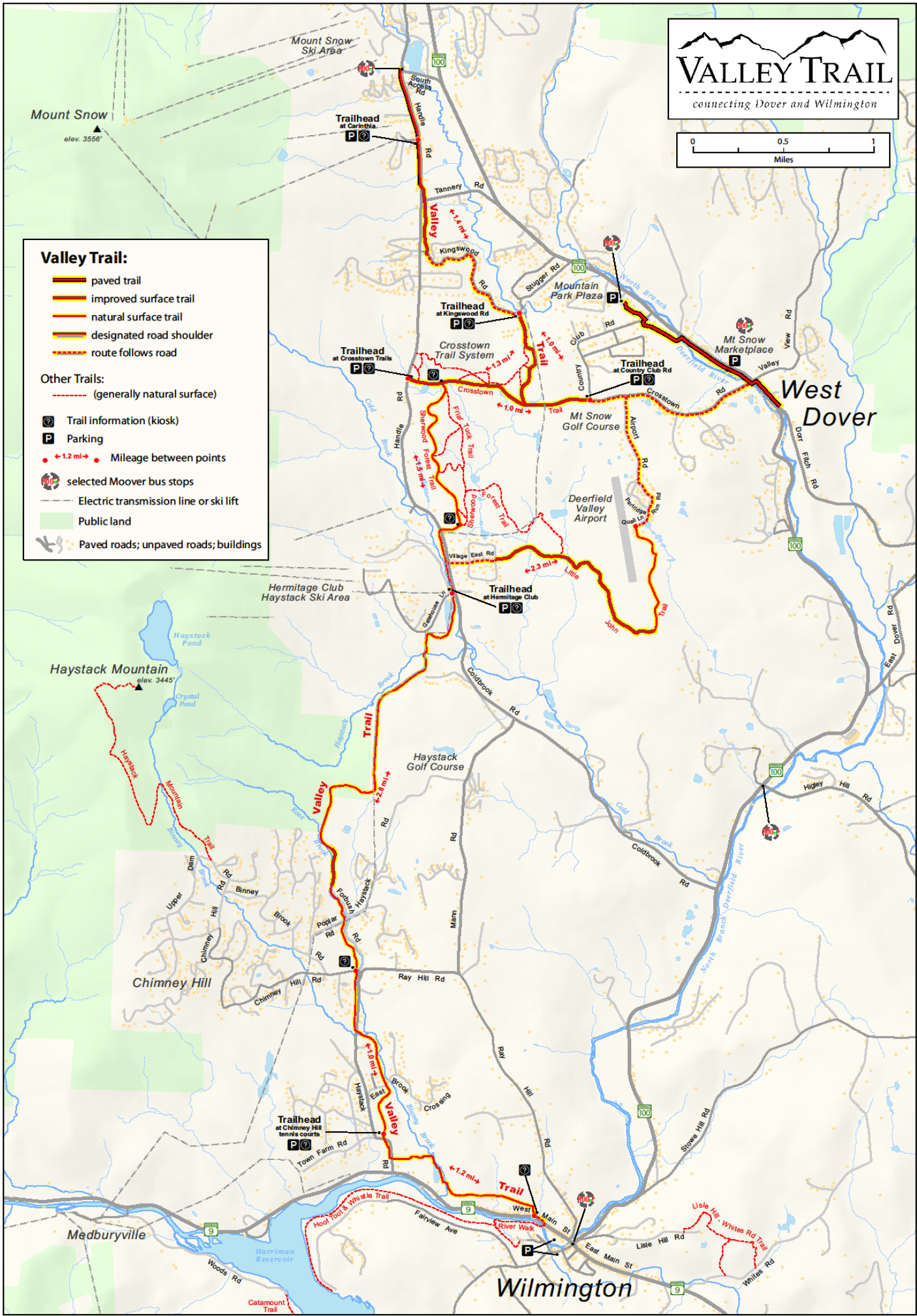
